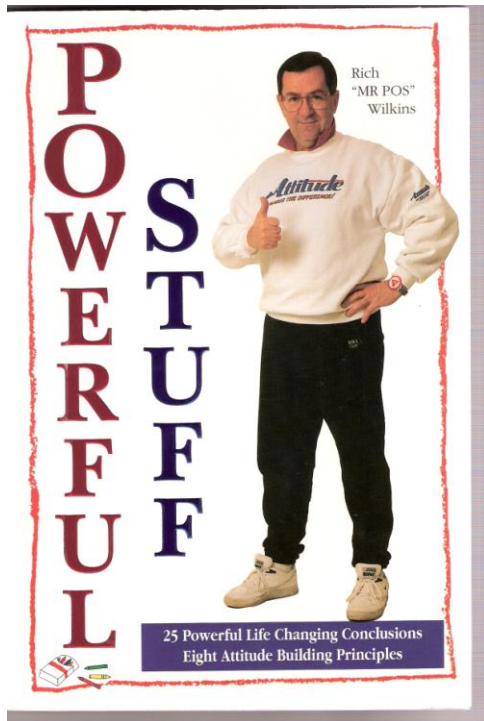

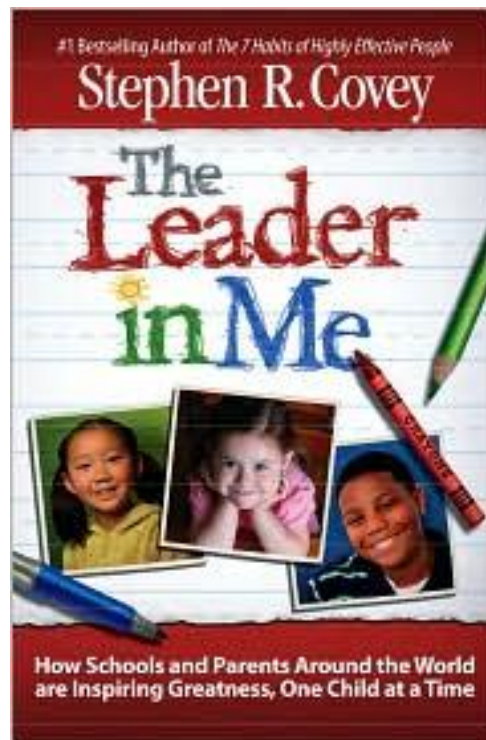

Program: Must meet deadlines for nomination, 5 letters of reference from participating parents or be in the STARS program, be established for at least 2 years, provide 3 items that verify quality (i.e. videos, pictures, newspaper articles, parent handbook, etc).

Director: Must meet deadlines for nominations, verification of Kentucky Director's credential, proof lifelong learner, fair and supportive supervisor, an advocate for children.

Direct Caregiver: Must meet deadlines for nomination, verification exceeds 21 hours annual training, 3 letters of reference from participating parents or school age children, verification of creating quality environments, at least 2 years experience.
